HEALTH OFFICIALS : H1N1 FLU VACCINE CLINIC TO BE HELD AT SUNRISE MALL THURSDAY AND FRIDAY

The Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District will hold an H1N1 (Swine) flu vaccination clinic indoors Thursday and Friday, October 29th and 30th from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. due to the possibility of inclement weather. It will be held at the former Oshman's Sports Store located at Sunrise Mall, 5858 S. Padre Island Drive located on the first floor. Individuals should enter through the former Chelsea Street Pub location on the South Padre Island Drive side.

The H1N1 flu vaccination clinic will be limited to these three high risk groups:

- Children ages 6 months to 5 years (not yet in school)
- Pregnant women
- Red Ticket Holders (pre-screened high risk)

In order to allow for an efficient flow of the clinic, the Health District is asking those who come to these two clinics to bring their consent forms, their questionnaire completed and signed. Forms will be available at the information center at Sunrise Mall, the Health District lobby or they can be downloaded on our website at www.ccpublichealth.com later this evening. Parents with red numbered tickets (numbers 1-500) bringing their child for the vaccine should remember to bring the red ticket with them. The H1N1 (Swine) flu vaccine is subject to availability.

Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. For more information contact the Health District at 826-7200.
