Construction Updates

Crews Complete Large Concrete Pour Near Curtis Clark Drive

This week the contractor completed a large concrete pour near Curtis Clark Drive. They also completed sidewalks near Cobblestone Lane and driveways from Holly Road to Cobblestone Lane.



Next week, construction crews will continue with the install of the storm sewer line between Curtis Clark Drive and south of Corona Drive. It is also anticipated that crews will continue pouring concrete roadway up to Curtis Clark Drive and sidewalks between Bonner Drive and Curtis Clark Drive.

Safety is a top priority, so motorists and pedestrians are reminded to be aware of the work zone, follow all traffic control devices, and use alternate routes to avoid delays.

All work is weather permitting.

Current Closures:

- Phase 4 will extend the closure of the southbound lanes of Everhart from Holly Road to Corona Drive for construction.
- Northbound and southbound traffic is shifted to the northbound lanes (East side of Everhart), from Holly Road to Corona Drive. Traffic is reduced to one-lane in each direction.
- The transition for southbound Everhart traffic occurs at the Corona Drive Intersection.
- Northbound traffic will not be allowed to turn left at Cobblestone Lane, Coventry Lane, Bonner Drive, Curtis Clark Drive, and Corona Drive.
- Southbound traffic will not be allowed to turn left on Curtis Clark Drive, Bonner Drive, Cain Drive, and Holly Road.
- Sidewalks will be closed along the westside of Everhart from Holly Road to Corona Drive.
- The westside of the Bonner Drive is closed at Everhart Road.
- The intersections of Cobblestone Lane, Coventry Lane, and Curtis Clark Drive will temporarily close when work is occurring at these intersections.
