Concrete Pouring Continues Along Phase 1

contractor completed the concrete pour of the roadway from Holly Road to Cain Drive. The contractor is expected to do another concrete pour in the coming weeks.

The contractor also completed the phase 2 installation of the 8" waterlines along Cain Drive and Curtis Clark Drive. As part of the phase 2 construction, additional street excavations are expected next week along with the installation of several

wastewater manholes and curb inlets. All work is weather permitting.



Closures include:

- Northbound lanes are closed from Holly Road to Curtis Clark Drive. The Southbound lanes from Holly Road to Curtis Clark Drive are two-way traffic
- Northbound traffic on Everhart Road will continue to be allowed to make left turns at
- the Holly Road intersection. However, left turns from Southbound Everhart Road traffic will still be restricted. The right turn lane on Holly Road will continue to be closed but right turns onto
- northbound Everhart Road will still be allowed from the right travel lane. Sidewalks will continue to be closed along Phase 1 until the completion of the
- project. Phase 2 sidewalks will also be closed along the east side of Everhart Road from Bonner Drive to Curtis Clark Drive. East half of Bonner Drive & Everhart Road is closed to through traffic.
- Phase 2 Northbound lanes are closed from Bonner Drive to Curtis Clark Drive.
- Southbound lanes from Bonner Drive to Curtis Clark Drive are two-way traffic lanes. Southbound traffic on Everhart Road will not be allowed to make a left turn on
- Curtis Clark Drive intersection.


